SMSAAM (SSE; SMSAAM) reports on operating volumes for December 2022 by business division

Towage

- In December maneuvers increased 10% with respect to 2021, due to greater market activity observed and the consolidation of new operations in Peru. YTD volumes climbed 3%.

Port Terminals

- At consolidated port terminals, volumes fell 8% in December, primarily due to a reconfiguration of services and fewer average containers per vessel. YTD volumes dropped 5% due to reduced calls and fewer containers per vessel.
- Volumes in associated terminals fell 21% versus 2021 mainly due to a high basis of comparison in Chile and a drop in volumes from calls associated with services from Asia. YTD there was a drop of 13% mainly because of a high basis of comparison.

Logistics

- Bonded warehouses: numbers fell 24%, mainly due to a drop in retail import volumes given the high basis of comparison. YTD shows a 2% increase over 2021, primarily due to the effects of port congestion observed during the first few months of 2022.
- Aerosan(3): tons handled decreased 3% in December compared to the prior the year due to the high basis of comparison and cargo flight cancellations associated with fewer imports. Tons handled were down 2% YTD compared to 2021.
