SMSAAM (SSE; SMSAAM) reports on operating volumes for February 2023 by business division **Towage**

Maneuvers were up 15% with respect to February 2022 and 11% YTD mainly due to increased activity in almost all markets, the reactivation of the cruise season, new service contracts, and growing operations in Peru.

Port Terminals

- In February consolidated terminals saw a 14% rise in throughput for the month (12% YTD), mostly because of growth in Bolivian cargo and increased containers at other terminals.
- Volumes at associate terminals fell 22% versus February 2022 (-24% YTD), explained by a decline in import volumes in Chile, mostly from Asian trades.

Logistics

- Bonded warehouses reported a 49% drop during the month and 51% YTD due to a high basis of comparison from the prior year because of increased warehousing by customers throughout the entire first half of 2022.
- Aerosan⁽²⁾: tons handled during the month of February decreased by 12% versus last year and 9% YTD mainly due to reduced exports of flowers and fresh produce.
