



SAAM – Operational Data 2024

Santiago, August 21, 2024

SMSAAM (SSE; SMSAAM) reports on operating volumes for July 2024 by business division.

Towage

- Harbour towage maneuvers were down 1% in July 2024 compared to the same month last year, mainly due to slow recovery after the Panama Canal transit restrictions and a smaller available fleet due to scheduled maintenance. YTD volumes increased by 3% compared to the previous year, mainly due to new tugboats in Brazil, offset by lower volumes in Panama.
- Time charter days—mostly associated with dedicated towage services at oil, gas and mining terminals—grew by 10% compared to July 2023 and 17% YTD, related mostly to new contracts in Brazil and St. Croix.
- As of June 2024, the company had two fewer tugs than in June 2023 due to planned sales of vessels that had reached the end of their useful life.

Aerosan

- Exports (metric tons) increased by 27% compared to the same month of the previous year and by 34% YTD, mainly due to the acquisition of Pertraly in Ecuador and increased activity in Chile because of the produce season early in the year.
- Imports (metric tons) grew by 33% compared to the same month of the previous year, primarily because new contracts went into effect in Chile and Colombia, along with recent market recovery mainly in Colombia. Metric tons were up 10% YTD, primarily due to new contracts in Chile and Colombia.
- The number of flights handled—associated with ground handling—decreased by 34% compared to the same month of the previous year, mainly because of the decision to reduce its presence in this segment. YTD there was a drop of 12% compared to the prior year.
