



SAAM – Operational Data 2025

Santiago, 19 August 2025

SMSAAM (SSE; SMSAAM) reports on operating volumes for July 2025 by business division.

Towage

- Harbour towage maneuvers in July 2025 were up 4% compared to the same period of 2024, explained by greater activity in Brazil and Chile, as well as a higher market share in Guatemala, which offset the decrease in Honduras. Year to date, volumes remained stable.
- *Time charter* days—mostly associated with dedicated towage services at oil, gas and mining terminals—showed a monthly decrease of 3%. Year to date, they fell 2%, mostly due to the termination of contracts in Honduras, which was partially offset by a new contract in Uruguay.
- The number of tugs during the month decreased by 1 unit with respect to the previous month (-7 vs July 2024), in line
 with the fleet plan. The change is explained by those vessels that reached the end of their useful life and the sale of
 pusher craft in Uruguay, following the closure of the barge business.

Aerosan

- Exports (metric tons) decreased by 2% compared to July 2024 and 10% YTD, due to a drop in air exports of salmon in Chile and a change in the customer mix in Colombia, which were partially offset by increased activity in Ecuador.
- Imports (metric tons) fell by 13% compared to the same month of the previous year due to a drop in cargo activity in Colombia. Year to date, they decreased 2%, thanks to increased activity and contracts in Chile, which partially offset the drop observed in Colombia.
