SMSAAM (SSE; SMSAAM) reports on operating volumes for August 2025 by business division

Towage

- SAAM Towage set a record for harbour towage maneuvers in August 2025, representing an increase of 3% over the same period in 2024. This volume can be explained by new contracts and increased activity in some markets, which offset the closure of its operations in Honduras. Year-to-date, there is no variation in volumes.
- Time charter days—associated mainly with dedicated towage services at oil, gas and mining terminals—were down 4% for the month and 2% YTD, explained primarily by the decrease in contracts in Honduras. However, these figures are still in line with the immediately preceding months.
- The number of tugs during the month decreased by 5 units with respect to August 2024 (+3 versus the previous month, -1 sold in Colombia), due to the planned sale of vessels that had completed their useful life and several pusher craft in Uruguay after its barge business was closed. The three additions include two new tugs for Chile and Peru, built in Turkey, and a lineboat in Canada, built in China.

Aerosan

- Exports (metric tons) decreased by 7% compared to August 2024 and 10% YTD, due to lower air exports from the salmon industry in Chile and the mix of customers in Colombia, partially offset by increased activity in Ecuador. However, August again showed an increase in total volumes over the previous month.
- Imports (metric tons) decreased by 12% compared to the same month of the previous year, due to lower cargo activity in Colombia and lower mining activity in Chile. They were down 3% YTD, mainly due to lower activity in Colombia.
